Student Lead x2

These people should have one year committee experience, the role is to organise committee meetings, be the link between the clinical academic leads and support the rest of the committee to ensure all events run smoothly.

Vice President

Supports the student leads with regular communication, bringing ideas and running the annual showcase with the student leads and supporting at other events.

Publicity

Managing the FB and Twitter accounts regularly to advertise events, also helping to design posters and FB events, emailing Medsoc etc. to ensure events are promoted widely.

Secretary

Taking minutes at meetings and distributing to committee members, keeping track of important documents and mailing lists.

Treasurer

Applying for external funding, looking after the society bank account.

Research Lead

Organise monthly research taster sessions with academic clinicians

Journal Club Lead

Organise monthly journal club sessions

Mentorship Lead

Organise the mentorship scheme - matching academics with students appropriately, following this up and organising events to encourage mentorship.

Careers Lead

Organising events such as how to apply for the AFP/how to intercalate and supporting the student leads with other large events.

Teaching coordinators x2

Organise peer teaching sessions throughout the year for BM6, year 1 and year 2 students.

Year Reps (1 per Year)

Ensure all events are advertised to your year group, bring ideas to the table and support the committee. Ensure your year's views and needs are represented for peer teaching plans and ensure other events are accessible and appropriate for your year.
