	<i>These notebooks and journals cover most of the adult life of William Francis Cowper Temple, first Baron Mount Temple. They are generally notes written for himself, often detailing his intimate thoughts on religious matters and his own spiritual well-being. Many of them have only a few leaves at the beginning filled in, and most of the rest of the book is left blank.</i>	
BR45/1	Notebook containing literary extracts, copied in the hand of William Francis Cowper, afterwards Cowper Temple, first Baron Mount Temple	1830
BR45/2	Locked (without a key) notebook, with a title pasted on the front cover to the effect that this is a private journal of a journey with the Duke of Devonshire in 1833, not in the hand of William Francis Cowper Temple: William was intimate with William George Spencer Cavendish, sixth Duke of Devonshire in the 1830s (see BR43/17/1-7)	1833
BR45/3/ 1-2	Two notebooks, the first quite full, the second with only a few leaves written on, in the hand of William Francis Cowper, afterwards Cowper Temple, first Baron Mount Temple, of religious notes under various headings	Apr 1841-54
BR45/4	Notebook, about one third full, of writings in the hand of William Francis Cowper, afterwards Cowper Temple, first Baron Mount Temple; he begins with a description of a church which leads into religious thoughts	Dec 1843
BR45/5	Journal in the hand of William Francis Cowper, afterwards Cowper Temple, first Baron Mount Temple, containing religious thoughts, and descriptions of social events and engagements	15 Jul 1850 - 31 Dec 1851
BR45/6/ 1-6	Six small, appointment diaries belonging to William Francis Cowper, afterwards Cowper Temple, first Baron Mount Temple	1861-70
BR45/7/ 1-2	Two notebooks; the first contains prayers, religious thoughts and extracts, in the hands of both William Francis Cowper, afterwards Cowper Temple, first Baron Mount Temple, and his wife, Georgina; the second, in William's hand, is apparently a glossary of religious terms and places	1865-8
BR45/8/ 1-2	Two notebooks, both containing religious notes and accounts of conversations with Thomas Lake Harris (see BR44/13/1-4), written in the hand of William Francis Cowper, afterwards Cowper Temple, first Baron Mount Temple; the second also has some religious notes made by Cowper at a later date	Jul 1865- Mar 1882
BR45/9	Notebook containing notes in the hand of William Francis Cowper Temple, first Baron Mount Temple, on religious thoughts, notes taken during lectures attended, literary extracts; also contains later notes on a conference at Broadlands	4 Dec 1865- 15 Dec 1878 Jul 1888
BR45/10	Notebook containing a small number of notes in the hand of William Francis Cowper, afterwards Cowper Temple, first Baron Mount Temple, on schools	1872

BR45/12/ 1-2	Two notebooks containing notes on religious subjects, in the hand of William Francis Cowper, afterwards Cowper Temple, first Baron Mount Temple	1876-82
BR45/13/ 1-5	Five notebooks, all containing notes in the hand of William Francis Cowper Temple, first Baron Mount Temple; one has lists of names on the first few leaves, two have religious notes, another has notes on various subjects, and the last has practical notes (on accommodation and related subjects) on a conference at Broadlands	1877-88
BR45/14	Notebook containing notes in the hand of William Francis Cowper Temple, first Baron Mount Temple, on biblical verses	1880
BR45/15/ 1-3	Three notebooks containing notes in the hand of William Francis Cowper Temple, first Baron Mount Temple, on the Welsh, the Irish, and Broadlands	1880-1
BR45/16	Notebook containing religious notes in the hand of William Francis Cowper Temple, first Baron Mount Temple	1881
BR45/17/ 1-3	Three notebooks containing notes in the hand of William Francis Cowper Temple, first Baron Mount Temple; two on education, one on ragged schools; none of them much written in	1883
BR45/18/ 1-4	Four notebooks, containing very few notes, in the hands of William Francis Cowper Temple, first Baron Mount Temple, and his wife, Georgina	1884-8
BR45/19	Notebook containing notes in the hand of William Francis Cowper Temple, first Baron Mount Temple, on a variety of religious topics, such as the abilities of preachers, and the Roman Catholic Church	1885-8
BR45/20	Four notebooks containing notes in the hand of Georgina Cowper Temple, Baroness Mount Temple, consisting mostly of literary or religious extracts, or of aphorisms	1891
BR45/21	Notebook containing a list of books and their situations, e.g. "top shelf", in an unidentified hand, not that of the Hon. Evelyn Ashley, or Wilfrid William Ashley, afterwards Baron Mount Temple of Lee	n.d. c.post 1901 [date of books]
BR45/22/ 1-19	Nineteen photographs of William Francis Cowper Temple, first Baron Mount Temple	n.d. c.1850-88
