By train:

- From London Waterloo, there are hourly trains to Alton. For further details on train times please visit the National Rail Enquiries website: www.nationalrail.co.uk
- There is a taxi rank outside the station. Alternatively, call Wilson's Taxis on 01420 87777, 85858 or 82226. Chawton House Library is about a 5-10 minute taxi ride from Alton station.
- There may be a shuttle service available between Alton and Chawton House Library in the morning, before the start of the conference, and from Chawton House Library back to Alton at the end of the conference. Further information to follow.

By car:

- From M25 Junction 10, A3 Guildford bypass, A31 Farnham and Alton bypass.
- Turn off left at A31/32 junction roundabout to Chawton and follow the brown tourist signs.
- From M25 Junction 12, M3 to Junction 5, B3349 to Odiham and Alton, follow signs for Chawton.

By bus:

- The 64 and X64 Stagecoach buses run between Winchester and Guildford, stopping at the A31/32 junction roundabout near Chawton.
- The 72 Stagecoach bus runs between Alton and Petersfield, stopping in Chawton.
