



Southampton Cancer Research UK Centre Summer Studentship scheme - 2015

The purpose of the awards is to provide experience of research to undergraduates with strong research potential, including medical students, and to encourage them to consider a career in cancer research.

The awards provide support for the student at a rate of £180 per week, for a period of between 6 and 8 weeks. Applications are made by the group leader and will require the student's CV, tutor's reference and project outline (max 200 words).

The deadline is **15th April** and applicants are encouraged to contact potential supervisors as soon as possible. For potential projects, students are advised to visit the Cancer Sciences website where it is possible to browse supervisors' webpages
