2	Copies of official despatches from the British negotiators at Nijmegen Temple, Jenkins and Lord Berkeley and later Jenkins and Laurence Hyde [later first Earl of Rochester], to Sir Joseph Williamson	5 Apr - 11 Oct 1677
3	Copies of official despatches from the British negotiators at Nijmegen, Jenkins and Hyde (and from December 1677 Jenkins alone) to Sir Joseph Williamson	15 Oct 1677 - 27 May 1678
4	Copies of official despatches from Sir Joseph Williamson and Henry Coventry, Secretaries of State for Foreign Affairs, to the British negotiators at Nijmegen	7 Jul 1676 - 5 Feb 1678
5	'State papers 1674 and 1675 Nimeguen': copies of correspondence, draft articles and other treaty papers, mainly of foreign ambassadors	25 Oct 1674 - 15 Jul 1677
6	Copies of letters, mainly official, addressed to Sir William Temple: writers include William III as Prince of Orange, James II, Duke of York and Charles II.	7 Oct 1665 - 1 Feb 1681
7	Copies of letters, mainly official, written of Sir William Temple	Nov 1672 - 24 Jun 1676
