## Who are eligible?

To be eligible for an award, you must be an Indian national residing in India and considering to submit a fresh application to any relevant degree programme starting in September 2018. Those who currently hold a conditional or unconditional offer to any of the following taught Masters programme are also eligible. Please note the scheme is not available for those who are in receipt of any funding either from Southampton or any external funding body.
