 You can fundraise for one of our two funds – Cancer Immunology or the Ignite Programme



Cancer Immunology Fund

The Cancer Immunology Fund supports our researchers and clinicians at the Centre for Cancer Immunology, to create new, life-saving treatments for cancer. The Centre is 100% dedicated to cancer immunology research and is the only one of its kind in the UK. Immunotherapy helps the body fight cancer itself, minimising harmful side-effects from treatments like chemotherapy. With your support, we can all look forward to the day when immunotherapy not only saves more lives but also allows patients a better quality of life after treatment.

Abi's Story

Abi was only 27 when she was diagnosed with melanoma, an advanced form of skin cancer, and was given two weeks to live.

Because of the support and generosity of people like you, Abi was able to visit University Hospital Southampton where she received life-saving immunotherapy treatment. In under 6 months, Abi went from receiving a terrible prognosis, to being completely cancer free – she was able to get back to living her life, and to start a family with her partner.

She has since gone on to fundraise for the Centre herself, cycling from Bournemouth to Brighton with her husband. Together, they raised a staggering £5,280.



The Ignite Programme

At the University of Southampton, we want all of our students to be able to thrive. Students from disadvantaged backgrounds face many barriers, meaning that they often struggle to achieve their full potential. Some even have to drop out.

The Ignite Programme – fully funded by donations from our community – aims to give these students a brighter future through a combination of financial, pastoral and mentoring support. Your fundraising will mean we can help even more of our most disadvantaged students to succeed, at university and beyond.

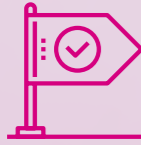


Laura's Story

Laura is such a hard worker – always excelling academically while having a range of part-time jobs to help pay her way. But during her first term, the overwhelming cost of university threatened everything she had worked and sacrificed to achieve. She was seriously considering dropping out and giving up her dreams of becoming a psychologist, when she received an email from our Ignite Programme that changed her life...

STEP 1: What do you want to do?

The possibilities for a fundraising activity are endless. You should choose something that is challenging, but that you will also enjoy!

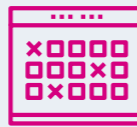
Once you're there, click the orange 'Start Fundraising' button, and set up your page.

STEP 3: Gain sponsors

Sharing a JustGiving page on social media is very simple and is one of the best ways to encourage sponsorship. What you are doing is very impressive, you just need to let people know about it. Tell all your friends, family, co-workers, pets – anyone you can think of, the more people the better! If you would like help with promoting your event, please contact our team.



STEP 4: Prepare for your event

Physically demanding events may need training beforehand, and a bake sale wouldn't be a bake sale without baked goods! This is your opportunity to show what you're made of and to get as ready as you can for your activity.



STEP 5: On the day

Enjoy your event! You should feel exceptionally proud of what you have accomplished and, should it get a little tough, remember to think of all the people that your fundraising is supporting. Well done!



STEP 6: After you've finished

Once you've completed your event, remember to thank all your donors and let us know how much you've raised. We'd also love to see any photos you have of the event, alongside any messages you'd like to send to those you're supporting.

Gift Aid

Sponsors can Gift Aid their donations as long as they are eligible and as long as you collect the appropriate details that will allow the University to claim the Gift Aid from HMRC.

Collecting Gift Aid from your Just Giving fundraising page

This is the easiest way to collect Gift Aid for your fundraising project because Just Giving will automatically ask your sponsors if they would like to add Gift Aid to their donation at the time of sponsorship.

Gift Aid Rules

If you are a UK taxpayer and meet the requirements set out below, the University of Southampton will be able to reclaim the basic rate of tax paid on your gift, increasing its value by 25p in every £ at no extra cost to you.

Please notify us if you want to cancel this declaration; you change your name or home address or if you no longer pay sufficient tax on your income and/or capital gains.

If you pay Income Tax at the higher or additional rate and want to receive the additional tax relief due to you, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self-Assessment tax return or ask HM Revenue and Customs to adjust your tax code.

SUSANNA'S STORY

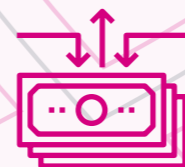
Susanna is passionate about making higher education accessible to everyone. She immediately saw the impact the Ignite Programme could have on disadvantaged young people coming to Southampton. She was shocked at how much some of these young people were struggling, and how many dropped out, and knew that she wanted to play her part in supporting them through the Programme.

“Seeing the stress that young people are under, compounded terribly by COVID, I wondered: just how do they get through that without strong parental and/or financial support?”

Seeing the challenges her own daughter was facing as she headed to uni, Susanna wanted to find a way to support Ignite. Through taking on a sponsored event, she knew she would make a bigger impact for the Programme than by simply donating by herself. She could spread the word about Ignite to her friends, family, and colleagues, acting as an advocate for the Programme as well as raising money for the cause.

A keen walker, Susanna took on the challenge of the Race to the King, a gruelling 53 mile hike across the South Downs from Arundel to Winchester. Despite tired legs, long days and some typically damp British weather, she remained motivated by thoughts of the students that she knew she would be helping.

Susanna's hard work paid off, as she raised an impressive £650 from over 30 donors! We are so proud to have people like Susanna as ambassadors and champions for our funds.

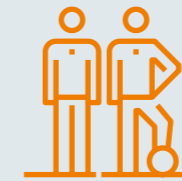

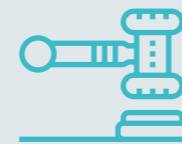
