


## Participant Recruitment

I am a healthcare professional who has experience in managing and diagnosis cellulitis and I am on the delegation log



I provide the patient with a PIS and if they are interested, I prescribe a 5-day course of flucloxacillin

I consent the patient using the paper consent form and send it to the SCTU via SafeSend coat@soton.ac.uk or eConsent on OpenClinica

I don't have time to complete the patient consent and/or registration during their appointment, so I **make a statement** in the patient notes confirming that the patient is eligible for the trial to allow confirmation of eligibility once the participant has given consent

I complete the eligibility assessment form and the clinical baseline form (either <u>on paper</u> or on <u>OpenClinica</u> – I will have to add the patient first if using OpenClinica)

I pass details of the patient onto a delegated member of the site research team to receive consent using <a href="econsent system">eConsent system</a>

I complete an Expression of Interest (EOI) form and send to the SCTU trial team for central consent

I am later informed that the patient provided consent, so I ask a member of the research team at my site (who is delegated to do so) to complete either the paper or electronic eligibility form using the statement I

provided in the medical notes.

I send all paperwork that is not entered directly on the database to the <u>SCTU trial team</u>











## Participant Recruitment



I do not diagnose cellulitis but am a delegated member of the research team\*



The patient has been assessed as being eligible and provided with a PIS and a 5-day course of flucloxacillin

I consent the patient using the paper consent form and send it to the SCTU via SafeSend coat@soton.ac.uk

I consent the patient using the eConsent form on the study database I complete an Expression of Interest (EOI) form and send to the SCTU trial team for central consent

I complete the paper <u>Contact Details Form</u> (this form can be completed in e.g. Word as no signature is required)

I ensure that a healthcare professional who has experience in diagnosing and managing cellulitis at my site has signed off an <u>eligibility paper form</u>, or verbally provided confirmation of their eligibility, so that I can complete the eligibility form in the <u>database</u> on their behalf (I will record the staff members name on this form as the person confirming eligibility).

I am later informed that the patient provided consent. I ensure that a healthcare professional who has experience in diagnosing and managing cellulitis at my site has signed off an eligibility paper form or made a statement in the patient notes confirming that the patient is eligible for the trial so that I can complete the eligibility form in the database on their behalf (I will record the staff members name on this form as the person confirming eligibility).

I am not on the COAT delegation log


I am a healthcare professional, but <u>not</u> a medically qualified doctor

I am a medically qualified doctor

I cannot complete eligibility assessments or other trialspecific procedures I can complete eligibility assessments

I provide the patient with a PIS and if they are interested, I prescribe a 5-day course of flucloxacilling

I make a statement in the patient notes confirming that the patient is eligible for the trial to allow confirmation of eligibility once the participant has given consent



I complete an <u>Expression of Interest (EOI) form</u> and send to the SCTU trial team for central consent

SCTU later informs site that the patient provided consent, so any delegated member of the research team at my site can complete either the paper or electronic eligibility form using the statement I provided in the medical notes.

A delegated member of the research team will then take care of the outstanding actions.





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
