The [logical framework](#) (red) for realising a vision provides a value structure (blue) for the contribution to human wellbeing from natural capital (green). The set of natural capital elements encompasses four dependent subsets of capital elements: financial, manufactured, human and social capitals. Anthropogenic drivers influence all six levels of the logical framework, directly (through land-use change, pollution, etc) and indirectly (through climate change, demography, technology, economy, etc).
